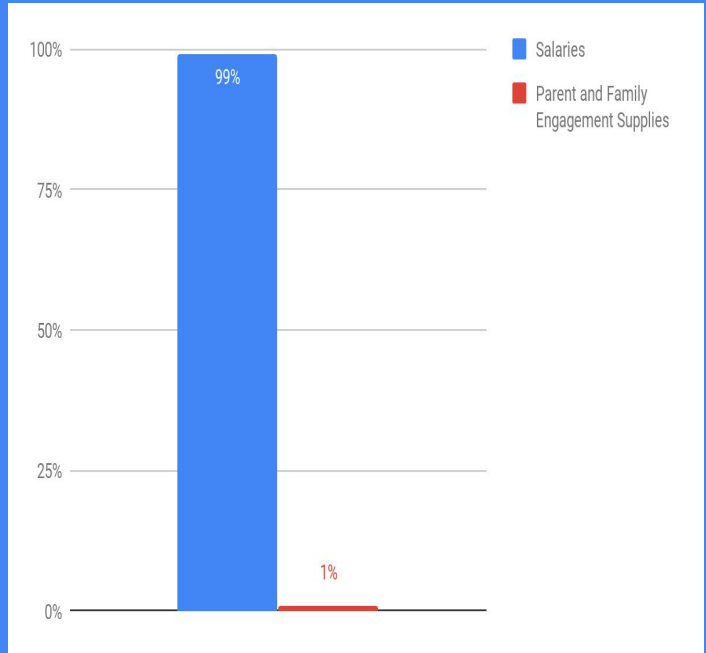
Title I Budget/Input

The district policy is also available for you to review today. Please leave us any comments or suggestions.

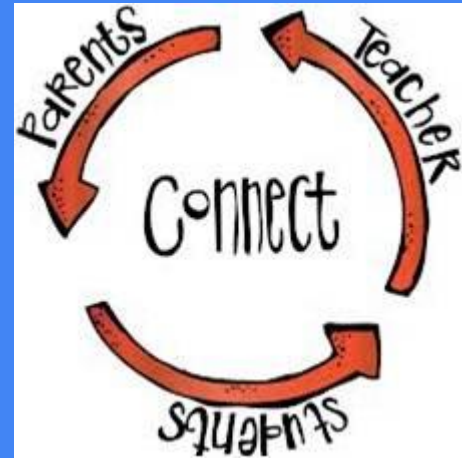

 - Reteach, small groups, individualize
- 4. How will we extend learning for those who know it?**
 - Deepen learning, produce a product based on standard or target

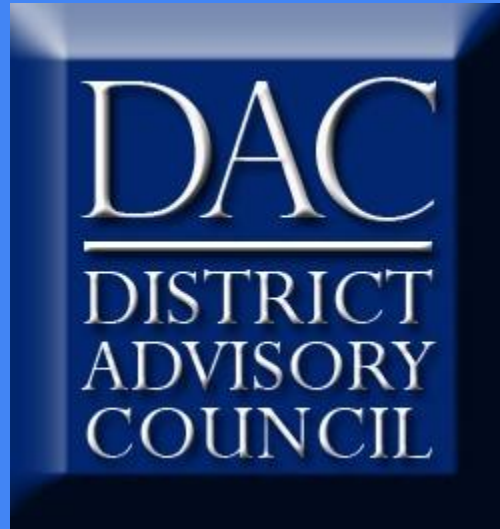
